Laser marking

When it comes to laser marking, we use a very fine high-powered laser beam to create a highly detailed mark. In addition to hallmarking, this high quality service is ideal for your personalised messages, lettering, serial numbers, stone weights, logos and signatures.

Punch making

We have pantograph engraving and state-of-the-art laser machines that enable us to offer a fast and efficient punch manufacturing service. We can make flat or curved punches on 'traditional straight' or 'swan neck' shanks. The punches are finished by hand to an exceptional standard and are suitable for hand marking or marking by press.

Expert services

The Assay Office has run the Antique Plate Committee (APC) since 1939, which is the internationally renowned body for adjudicating spurious silver. We also work closely with the Trading Standards Authorities providing inspection assistance, testing and expert witness statements for test purchases and seizures thought to flout the Hallmarking Act.



Valuations

We offer professional valuations for jewellery, watches and silverware either by valuation days at Goldsmiths' Hall or at your store, drop-off services, secure postal services and home visits. Every item is registered on our confidential e-register database ensuring it is properly protected in the event of loss or theft. Valuations also mean that you will have the correct level of insurance cover.

Laboratory

We use sophisticated modern techniques, state-of-theart equipment and rigorous procedures. Our laboratory is fully independent and UKAS-accredited and we offer nickel testing, antique silver dating, complete compositional analysis of metal alloys, plating thickness measurement, smelting and analysis of jewellery sweeps, powders and ores.

Trial of the Pyx

Every year we are asked to verify that the UK coins produced at the Royal Mint are within statutory limits – this is known as the Trial of the Pyx and has taken place since 1246. Hosted in Goldsmiths' Hall, this important event is presided over by HM The Queen's Remembrancer. The name 'Pyx' refers to the chests in which coins are transported and derives from the Pyx Chamber in Westminster Abbey.
